

KPAC Golf League 2011

Intention to Participate

We are embarking on our inaugural season of the KPAC Golf League. We are excited about our second season and are hoping that we get representation from each school. Here is what has been planned. **(NEW DATES IN RED)**

Opening event: Evaluation Day (\$25.00 per golfer), **Thursday, April 21st**, 2011

Tee-off: 3:30 start (We plan on having a shot-gun start)

Format: 18 hole, stroke play event to determine the tiering of the schools.

Entries: All golfers (male or female) who will be competing in league play competition should try to take part. Each school can send a maximum of 8 golfers to this event. Adam Boge, Head Professional at The Meadows will go through the results and place teams in the tier they will compete in.

League Dates: **May 4th**, May 5th, **May 11th**, May 12th, May 19th and May 26th

Format: Two players (male or female) from one school will play two players from another school in a 9 hole, best ball, match play competition. Each match will consist of three points, one point for each set of three holes.

Playoffs: Playoff dates will be **June 2nd** and **June 3rd**. The top four teams in each tier will make the playoffs. Separate trophies will be awarded for champions in each tier.

Costs: \$210.00 per team. Cheques should be made payable to **Marketing Without Borders** and payment is due prior to the Opening Event. Costs are to be covered by participating athletes although schools are free to cover these costs if they choose to. Coaches, please do not have players making individual payments. **Only one cheque per school/coach please.**

Fundraising: *Golf Discount* booklets will be available to teams to sell to cover the cost of their expenses. Booklets are sold for \$30.00 and \$15.00 is kept for the team. 20 booklets will be given to each team.

Supervision: All league matches will require that there be a supervisor present. A list will be made and each school will be responsible for providing a supervisor/marshal for one evening. All supervisors/coaches will have access to range balls, while their athletes are on the course.

League Standings: At the conclusion of each set of matches the results need to be submitted to Adam Boge or a member of The Meadows Golf Club in the pro-shop. The score cards should be collected by the supervising teacher and submitted. Adam Boge has volunteered to tabulate and record all results from this our inaugural season. Our hope is to also have the results forwarded to Gerry Badiou at Transcona Collegiate so they can be posted on the KPAC web site.

Important Notes:

1. Teachers or golf coaches DO NOT GOLF in league play or Evaluation Day. *However, teachers / golf coaches will have access to range balls while their athletes are on the course.*
2. The KPAC Golf League does not in any way replace the KPAC Golf Championships held in the fall.
3. Schools may have coaches walk with the players during league play but there should not be any coaching during the round.
